Woodland High School Progressive Discipline Plan 2022/2023

Seclusion and/or restraint of a student may be used for the management of behavior when any student poses a threat of imminent, serious, physical harm to self and/or others, and has the ability to cause such harm. DD4 adheres to the SC Department of Education's Guidelines for the Use of Seclusion and Restraint. If parents have concerns, contact should be made with the school administration for resolution.

Expulsion Referrals: Level 3 offenses will be referred to the District Office as outlined in the Progressive Discipline Plan. Before referring a Special Education or 504 student for expulsion, a Manifestation Determination Review meeting must be conducted. If the incident is related to the student's disability, then no further discipline occurs. If the incident is NOT related to the student's disability, then a referral for expulsion may be submitted. All referrals for inervention or expulsion should be submitted to the district office.
