- Graduation practice will be at Carden Jarrell Field (unless otherwise noted due to inclement weather) at 8:00 AM Friday morning, 5/27. GRADUATES MUST BE PRESENT AT PRACTICE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE FRIDAY EVENING! Graduates must be at practice on time so that seats can be assigned correctly. Any graduate not at practice will not have a seat on Friday evening.
- 2. Seniors must provide their own transportation to and from practice.
- 3. Commencement exercises will be Friday evening, May 27, at 7:00 pm. Seniors need to be present by 5:30 pm. Reserved parking will be behind the scoreboard or at the bus loading zone if the ceremony is at the high school. The ceremony will also be streamed live on Youtube.com under "Raider TV" live stream as well as under the Thunder Radio and Rooster Facebook Live pages.
- 4. Graduates MUST wear their caps and gowns in order to participate. Gowns should be zipped and caps worn throughout the ceremony. You will not need your cap and gown for practice.
- 5. Caps may be decorated on top, but must be school appropriate (No profanity or inappropriate pictures, content, or innuendo), no wider than the cap, and not taller than 2 inches. Gowns MAY NOT be decorated.
- 6. Be mindful that commencement is a formal occasion and appropriate dress is required. No apparel or grooming that is or may be potentially disruptive will be permitted. If there is a question as to what is appropriate, please ask. If you need assistance with acquiring appropriate attire, please see your assigned administrator as soon as possible.
- Any disruptions to this ceremony could result in disciplinary and/or legal action. In the event of such an action, the student will be escorted from the field/gym and his/her diploma will be withheld.
- 8. Beach balls, confetti, silly string, etc. will not be allowed on the field or in the gym.
- 9. All debts and obligations must be met (school owes paid, textbooks, uniforms, etc. returned) by Monday, May 23, 2022 in order for students to be eligible to walk.
- 10. This commencement information form must be signed by the student and his/her parent or guardian and then returned to your homeroom teacher by Friday, May 19. Anyone who does not have a homeroom should submit the form to Mrs. Wright in the main office. Any senior who does not return the form will not be allowed to march.
