

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

This program is for High School Students who are in 12th grade, <u>have successfully completed the EMR</u> <u>program</u> in which they demonstrated the ability to successfully engage in the increased demands, responsibility, and critical thinking that is required in gaining the EMT certification. **Students must continue to meet all of the same above requirements outlined for acceptance of EMR students.** Students must show that they have the ability to learn the basic knowledge and skills necessary to stabilize and safely transport patients in non-emergency and routine medical transports to life threatening emergencies with the basic equipment typically found on an ambulance under medical oversight. For admission into this program, the student's High School submits an application to the district committee. If the student meets the program requirements, WEIC contacts the parent/guardian to set up an interview. Please contact your student's school counselor for more information.
