TK is working with the letters M, A, T, D, O, E, S, G, F, W, P, Y, J, I, and C and recognizing beginning sounds in words. They will continue learning about desert habitats after the break.

In math, kindergarteners are learning shapes and their attributes. They learned the terms curve and vertex. They also discovered that a rectangle is a square, but a square is not a rectangle. After the break, they will learn about three-dimensional shapes. TK is learning about comparing amounts and sizes. They compare two groups to determine if they have less, more, or the same.
