

STUDENT PERSONAL LAPTOP USE POLICY

In response to a growing demand for students to connect personal-computing devices to the Lincoln Woodstock Cooperative School District (LWCSD) network this policy was developed to protect all parties' interests.

The following guidelines have been established in order to protect both the users and the integrity of the LWCSD network. By signing this document the student and his/her parents agree to the outlined conditions;

- 1. LWCSD will not be held liable for any damage that may occur to the personal-computing device as a result of connecting to the network or AC power source.
- 2. LWCSD will not be held responsible for any physical damage, loss or theft of the personal-computing device
- 3. Any student using a personal-computing device on the network must have a signed and approved Acceptable Use Policy on file in the school.
- 4. LWCSD will reserve the right to inspect any personal-computing device for the purpose of ensuring network stability and adherence to the Acceptable Use Policy.
- 5. LWCSD will not be obligated to supply AC power access where such access does not already exist.
- 6. Use of personal-computing devices in the classroom setting will be at the discretion of the instructor.
- 7. All personal-computing devices must be registered with the technology department prior to connecting to the network.
