#### Parent/Family Engagement Activity

#### Parent Liaison

LeighAnn Womack is our parent liaison works 15 hours a week at the school. While at school she works on all things parental engagement.

#### Grade Level Orientation Video

Prior to the beginning of school, PowerPoint presentations for Pre-K – fifth grades were posted to the school website. #### **Pre-K Orientation**
