ADDITIONAL PRGRAM NOTES:

The district has 8 serving sites that participate in the NSLP and SBP. The Lake Havasu High School and Thunderbolt Middle School are setup as Production Kitchens. Currently, Lake Havasu High kitchen, produces all meals for the 6 elementary sites, plus its own population. The Thunderbolt Middle School kitchen produces for the middle school only.

The district has no central warehouse facility for food service. DOD orders are received at Lake Havasu High, and Thunderbolt Middle. USDA Foods (brown box) are received at the Lake Havasu High School, with overflow/extra storage at Thunderbolt Middle School.

Milk is ordered by the individual site kitchen leads, and is delivered twice a week. The milk is currently purchased by the SFA from Shamrock Farms procured through the Mohave Purchasing Contract.

The incumbent FSMC does not own/lease any equipment that would leave with the vendor in a transition. The FSMC Director computer/laptop is the property of the incumbent FSMC.

The District salaries listed on the AFR, not the FSMC breakdown section, include the Child Nutrition Supervisor, Food Service Technologist, and a portion of other employees with time working on Food Service matters. The amount could go up over the next five years, depending on salary increases.

The pre-proposal tour will incorporate Thunderbolt Middle School, Lake Havasu High School, and Smoketree Elementary School. In the interest of complete disclosure, please be aware that Smoketree Elementary and Jamaica Elementary kitchens of very similar in design. Nautilus Elementary and Havasupai Elementary schools share the same design and their kitchens are represented in the following photos:
