HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – In a thrilling display of airpower and community support, the Georgia Air National Guard will perform a flyover at Herb St. John Stadium in Perry just before the 7:30 p.m. kickoff at the Panther's August 30 home football game. The Georgia Air National Guard will perform the flyover to commemorate National Purple Heart Day, and the football game will be dedicated to Purple Heart Veterans in the local community. This flyover will precede the highly anticipated match-up between Perry High School, current AAAA State Champions, and cross-town


The flyover will feature a C-130J from the 165th Airlift Wing, near Savannah, showcasing the skill and precision of our dedicated Air National Guard Airmen. It will be timed to coincide with the last note of the Star-Spangled Banner, played by the Panther Regiment Band, as the school's decorated Color Guard presents the colors.

Lt Col Tom Alford, Air Force JROTC Instructor, said, "We have a close relationship with our Guardsmen, and we are completely honored to have them flyover Panther Stadium before the game."
