We had some powerful noticings in PLCs this week. Our students are not showing (or nearing) mastery on the data trackers. We have pinpointed one cause as misalingment between how we are teaching and how they are being assessed. We must follow the item specs and practice how they will be assessed

THE PLAN

Use our data to identify students for small group instruction, peer walkthroughs to sharpen skills in explicit instruction/aligning tasks to item specs, and an intense focus on independent practice/weekly checks for understanding to increase alignment with (MAP like) performance tasks.
