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Math Tips for Parents

Practice Math Facts Daily – Quick recall of basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts helps with problem-solving. Use flashcards, apps, or games like "Around the World" to make it fun! Look for Math in Everyday Life - Let your child help with grocery shopping by estimating totals, comparing prices, or measuring ingredients when cooking. Use Timers for Fluency Practice – Set a timer for one or two minutes and see how many math problems your child can solve correctly. Celebrate progress! Talk About Numbers - Point out patterns, shapes, and numbers in the real world. Ask questions like, "How many more do we need?" or "What's another way to solve this?"

Reading Tips for Parents

Read Together Every Day - Whether it's a bedtime story or taking turns reading pages, shared reading helps build fluency and comprehension. Ask Questions While Reading -Pause to ask, "What do you think will happen next?" or "Why do you think the character did that?" This builds critical thinking skills. Encourage Sounding Out Words – If your child gets stuck on a word, encourage them to use their phonics skills rather than guessing. Make Reading Interactive – Have your child act out parts of the story, draw a picture of what happened, or retell the story in their own words. Let Them Choose Books - Children are more motivated to read when they get to pick books that interest them. Visit the library together!
