Dear Parishioners,

A lot can happen in a week! In between the time of my writing my Pastor's notes and publication of such notes, in particular. I am pleased to write that Corissa Van Kuelen has accepted the position of Director of Religious Education. She will be transitioning into the position over the next weeks, and we should be ready to begin the RE vear on September 13. Information on registration will be out shortly, so please watch for it in email, our parish website, or on Facebook. Again, we are requesting EVERY family register so that we can have up-to-date contact information, numbers for texts and other issues, and an accurate class list.

Monday of this last week, I had a checkup at the Heart Hospital. There is nothing to report which is a good thing. As long as I am able, I am free to exercise as I have been these last two years with running two 15-minute sessions in an hour of exercise. This week, I have a pre-op for a colonoscopy which is scheduled for mid-September. I suspect no major findings from that, either, despite some ongoing issues with pain and nausea.

Monday of this week in the Feast of St. Augustine. He is a hero saint of mine. He was very well educated, was caught in a dualist world view, and lived a with a woman he would not marry. His mother St. Monica (celebrated August 27 – suppressed this year by Sunday) prayed for his conversion (along with the conversion of her often drunk and abusive husband), and through a number of circumstances like encountering the preaching of St. Ambrose of Milan, Augustine had a dramatic conversion.

St. Augustine became Bishop of Hippo (in modern day Libya) and wrote several important works, such as His Confessions (an account of his life in which he confesses his faith), City of God, a number of homilies and treatises on almost every topic of faith.

Many idioms are related to him, St. Monica, or St. Ambrose. He reportedly prayed, "Lord, give me chastity, but not yet." The Lord gave it after his conversion. "You are what you eat" is from his homily on the Eucharist, in which we become the Body of Christ. "When in Rome..." was St. Ambrose's advice to St. Monica who was confused what to do as she was accustomed to fasting Wednesdays and Fridays at home, but only Fridays in Rome. "It's all Greek to me" was St. Augustine's response to not being able to read the Scriptures in Hebrew, realizing he was limited to the Greek Septuagint for Old Testament studies.

St Augustine is also the most quoted after the Scriptures and Aristotle in the Summa of St. Thomas Aquinas, and the most used writer for the Office of Readings in the Liturgy of the Hours.


