Previewing Content

While the students continue to focus on their Exact Path learning paths for specific, targeted interventions, we began previewing math content during the second quarter grading period with promising results. In talking with the students, many of them felt more comfortable learning new content in a smaller setting, and many of them felt more confident in themselves when their academic class began working on the skills they had already previewed. We will be previewing the following math skills over the next week in hopes that the students will continue to work towards skill mastery.

Tier 1 Intervention of the Month: Listening Passage Preview

One easy-to-implement intervention for students with reading deficiencies is the Listening Passage Preview. In this intervention the struggling reader will have a passage read to them by an accomplished reader. The student will then read the passage back to the accomplished reader, receiving corrective feedback where needed. This is easy to implement, and with planning would provide data to determine if the intervention is helping the student with reading fluency or comprehension issues.

--AREA OF FOCUS--

One of our areas of focus is helping students maintain passing grades in their academic classes.
