



Scholar Uniform Policy - K - 6th Grades

Our uniform policy is designed to minimize distractions, create uniformity and increase school pride. Scholars are expected to wear their complete school uniforms to school every day, including field lessons. Scholars are expected to wear the following:

UNIFORM POLICY COLLEGIATE PRIMARY & INTERMEDIATE - K - 6TH GRADES	
Shirts	K-3rd Purple polo shirt <u>with school issued logo</u> . 4th-6th : Gold polo shirt <u>with school issued logo</u> . Plain short or long sleeve undershirts are allowed. Fridays Only: College t-shirts or school t-shirts may be worn. Jerseys are not allowed.
Sweatshirts or Cardigans	Black <u>school issued logo</u> sweatshirt, black <u>school issued logo</u> fleece, or <u>school issued logo</u> cardigans. The Clarksdale Collegiate polo shirt must be seen when a sweatshirt, fleece, or cardigan is worn. <i>Shirts, sweaters, and fleece jackets without the official Clarksdale Collegiate logo are not allowed to be worn inside the classroom.</i> Fridays Only: College sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn. No hoodies may be worn.
Pants	Khaki pants. Khaki shorts or capris. Khaki skirts, skorts, or jumpers. <i>Skirts and shorts should be knee length or no more than 2 inches above the knee.</i> Fridays Only: Solid blue or black jean pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts may be worn. Jeans should be free of rips and holes. Sweat pants, track pants, leggings and/or basketball shorts are not allowed.
Shoes	<u>Sneakers are required</u> as scholars have recess daily. Shoes must be closed-toed, flat, rubber-soled shoes. Snow or Rain boots can be worn to and from school, with a change of shoes brought in a backpack. <i>Light-up shoes, shoes with wheels, crocs, sandals, any type of boots, or otherwise distracting shoes are not allowed.</i>
Belts	Belts are highly encouraged if bottoms have belt loops.
Jewelry and Nails	Scholars may not wear bracelets, rings, or other jewelry that prevent them from writing properly or distracts them from learning in any way. Earrings must be dime sized or smaller. Talking/beeping watches or smart watches are disruptive and are not allowed. Artificial nails are not allowed in K-2 as scholars are still developing writing skills. Scholars in 3-6 may wear artificial nails at a length that does not cause disruption in writing, or typing and is not a distraction from learning. Scholars must also be able to participate in recess & PE.
Headwear	Scholars are not allowed to wear hats, headwear, or hoodies inside the building unless worn for religious purposes (with documentation).

Scholar Uniform Policy - 7th - 10th Grades

Our uniform policy is designed to minimize distractions, create uniformity and increase school pride. Scholars are expected to wear their complete school uniforms to school every day, including field lessons. Scholars are expected to wear the following:

UNIFORM POLICY COLLEGIATE MIDDLE & COLLEGIATE HIGH - 7TH - 10TH GRADE	
Shirts	7-10th: White button-down short or long sleeve shirt with or without school logo. Fridays Only: <i>College t-shirts or school t-shirts may be worn. Jerseys are not allowed.</i>
Cardigans or Sweaters	Black <u>school issued logo</u> fleece, <u>school issued logo</u> cardigans, or <u>school issued logo</u> sweater vest. A white button-down shirt must be seen when a fleece, cardigan, or sweater vest is worn. <i>Sweatshirts are not allowed and sweaters and fleeces without the Clarksdale Collegiate logo are not allowed to be worn inside the classroom.</i> Fridays Only: <i>College crewneck sweaters or crewneck sweatshirts may be worn. No hoodies may be worn.</i>
Pants	Khaki or black pants. Khaki or black shorts or capris. Khaki or black skirts, skorts, or jumpers. <i>Skirts and shorts should be knee length or no more than 2 inches above the knee.</i> Fridays Only: <i>Blue jean pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts may be worn. Jeans should be free of rips and holes. Sweat pants, track pants, leggings, and/or basketball shorts are not allowed. The following prints are also not permitted, camouflage.</i>
Shoes	Sneakers or casual shoes. All shoes must be closed-toed, flat, rubber-soled shoes. Snow or Rain boots can be worn to and from school, with a change of shoes brought in a backpack. <i>Shoes or boots with high heels, high wedges, or high platforms are not allowed. Any open-toe sandals, flip-flops, crocs, or distracting shoes are not allowed.</i>
Belts	Belts are required if bottoms have belt loops.
Jewelry and Nails	Scholars may not wear bracelets, rings, or other jewelry that prevent them from writing properly or distracts them or others from learning in any way. Earrings must be quarter-sized or smaller. Talking/beeping watches or smart watches are disruptive and are not allowed. Artificial nails at a length that does not cause disruption in writing, typing, physical education, or the learning environment are allowed.
Headwear	Scholars are not allowed to wear hats, headwear, skull caps, ski masks, hair bonnets, scarves or hoodies inside the building unless worn for religious purposes (with documentation).

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
