

Gholson ISD Fan and Spectator Policy

All Administrators for University Interscholastic League (UIL) sanctioned sports from Gholson ISD and all District and Non-District ISD's will follow the "Behavior Expectations of Spectators" as set forth in the guidelines of the UIL. This includes Administrator Designees as assigned by Gholson ISD or other UIL member institutions. While your support of Gholson ISD Athletics is appreciated, all fans and spectators must conduct themselves in a way to bring dignity and respect to both Gholson ISD and the community.

1st Offense:

Any spectator asked to leave by an Administrator or Designee from Gholson ISD or any other school hosting an UIL sanctioned sporting event will be suspended from all Gholson ISD athletic events, at home and away for 30 calendar days. During that period, the spectator must meet with the Gholson ISD Superintendent, Athletic Director, and/or Principal before returning to any athletic events. This plan includes ejections initiated by any game official.

2nd Offense:

Any spectator asked to leave by an Administrator or Designee from Gholson ISD or any other school hosting an UIL sanctioned sporting event for a second time will be suspended from all Gholson ISD athletic events, at home and away for 150 calendar days. If the suspension takes place within 150 days of the end of the school year, this suspension will carry over into the next school year (i.e., suspensions taking place during the softball or baseball seasons). During that period, the spectator must meet with the Gholson ISD Superintendent, Athletic Director, and/or Principal before returning to any athletic events. This plan includes ejections initiated by any game official.

3rd Offense:

Any spectator asked to leave by an Administrator or Designee from Gholson ISD or any other school hosting an UIL sanctioned sporting event for a third time will be suspended from all Gholson ISD athletic events, at home and away for a full calendar year. During that period, the spectator must meet with the Gholson ISD Superintendent, Athletic Director, and/or Principal before returning to any athletic events. This plan includes ejections initiated by any game official.

***** Any incidents involving threats, physical altercations, or deemed "severe" by said Administrator or Designee could result in suspension for a full calendar year.***
