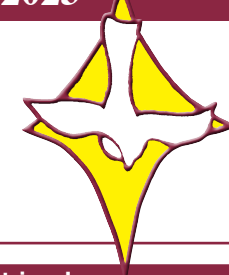

Even with all the hard work and events going on, we still find time to celebrate here at the home.

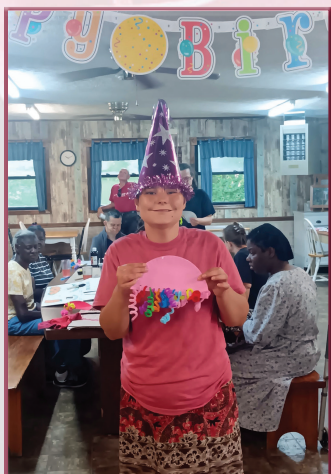


Daycare excited about their Art Project
