Thursday, January 18, 2024

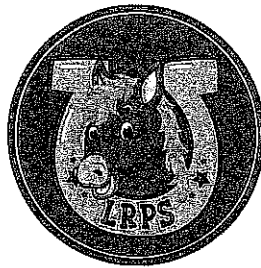
The meeting was called to order at 4:47 pm. All attendees were introduced by Dr. Rush.
