COVID Protocol



Level 1

- The district will monitor the number of cases in the school setting.
- Deep clean areas where positive cases spent time.
- Public health staff will direct contact tracing for quarantine.
- Mask are not required in the building.
- The district will work with the health department to provide information about vaccines to students and staff.
- Masks are required on buses (EO 2021-585)

Level 2

- The district will monitor cases in school setting and in the community.
- Schools will remain open at the discretion of school administration.
- Public health staff will direct contact tracing for quarantine.
- Masks are optional discretion to change based on student/staff rates in schools.
- Visitors/volunteers will be limited.
- Field trips will be limited.
- Deep clean areas where positive cases spent time.
- Masks are required on buses (EO 2021-585)

Level 3

- The district will consult with local health department officials concerning school and community positivity.
- Schools will remain open if possible, but may need to utilize NTI Days.
- Public health staff will direct contact tracing for quarantine.
- Masks are required discretion to change based on student/staff rates in schools
- Large public events may be postponed.
- Visitors/volunteers may be restricted.
- Field Trips may be suspended.
- Deep clean the entire school.
- Masks are required on buses (EO 2021-585)

Ballard County Schools is committed to the safety of our students. Vaccinations for those eligible are encouraged. Community transmission numbers will be monitored to gauge the status of spread within our community. The district will announce on its webpage and social media when we change from one Level to another; until the school has publicized a change, families should not assume we have changed levels. – Revised 9/21/21
