AWARDS DAY and COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE

• EVERY GRADUATE MUST BE DRESSED APPROPRIATELY!

Males wear: DRESS SHIRT, DRESS PANTS, TIE, and DRESS SHOES

Females wear: DRESS OR PANT SUIT**DRESS SHOES**

- NO TENNIS SHOES OR FLIP FLOPS!
- USE CAUTION WHEN IRONING/STEAMING GOWNS. A COOL IRON IS BEST.
- STUDENTS NEED TO BRING ALL ITEMS WITH THEM... CAP, TASSEL, GOWN, HONOR CORDS...IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO HAVE EVERYTHING THAT YOU NEED ORGANIZED THE NIGHT BEFORE.
- CAPS MUST REMAIN ON AT ALL TIMES... THE MORTARBOARD MUST BE WORN PARALLEL TO THE FLOOR (NOT TILTED) WITH THE TASSEL HANGING TO THERIGHT.
- Decorating your cap is not required. IF YOU CHOOSE TO
 DECORATE YOUR CAP, THEN YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN
 RISK. You must adhere to the RULES FOR DECORATING YOUR
 GRADUATION CAP. If your cap gets damaged while decorating, we
 have NO extra caps.
- THE SPONSORS HAVE NO EXTRA PARTS TO THE CAPS AND GOWNS...IF YOU ARE MISSING AN ITEM THEN TRY TO CONTACTA GRADUATE FROM A PREVIOUS YEAR..THERE ARE NO EXTRAS!

RULES FOR DECORATING YOUR GRADUATION CAP

Decorating your cap is NOT a requirement and is done at your own risk!

Graduation caps must be reviewed and approved in advance of the Awards Day program. You must see a senior class sponsor.

The mortarboard MUST be worn parallel to the floor (NOT TILTED).

Follow these rules when decorating your graduation cap. Failure to follow these rules will result in your cap being taken away and you will not be able to participate in the ceremony.

- Nothing obscene, profane, vulgar or lewd.
- No symbols, advertisements, initials, abbreviations, words, slogans, patches or pictures that refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, weapons or be of a sexual nature.
- Can not denote an affiliation with gangs or which advocate drug use, violence, illegal
 activity, or disruptive behavior which is detrimental to the safety and welfare of other
 students.
- Can not threaten the safety or welfare of any person.
- Only the flat, top area of the cap may be decorated.
- Nothing can be hanging off from the sides.
- Decorations must be flat on the surface, 3-D creations are prohibited.
- No blinking lights, nothing battery operated.
- Make sure the decorations will not come off your cap.
- Do not use anything that will make noise...no bells, whistles, etc.

The following examples are appropriate to put on your cap:

- Thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, or friend.
- Recognize the university you will attend.
- The year you are graduating.
- The branch of the military you will be joining.

- ALL seniors must complete and turn in the COMMENCEMENT LUNCHEON FORM.
- ONLY seniors that plan on attending the luncheon must complete the FIELD TRIP PERMISSION FORM.
- There is no cost to attend the luncheon.
- Students will provide their own transportation to Sampey Park.
- Students will be required to sign in at the luncheon no later than 10:45 a.m. AND sign out no earlier than 1:00 p.m.
- If you cancel your reservation for the luncheon after Friday, May 13th OR skip the luncheon, you will owe the Senior Class \$25 for your meal. A hold slip will be filed with the office.
- Students who skip the luncheon or leave early without permission will NOT walk at commencement.
- Students will be given time after the SENIOR PROMENADE to change into more comfortable clothing before heading to Sampey Park.
- For added fun, please feel free to bring a frisbee, football, volleyball, cornhole, etc. with you to Sampey Park.

COMMENCEMENT TICKETS / SEATING

- EACH graduate will receive 4 TICKETS at the end of commencement practice.
- Due to auditorium capacity and number of graduates, there will only be a SMALL number of extra tickets available. Any graduate requiring an extra ticket will need to line up near the stage AFTER commencement practice. Again, there are only a limited number of extra tickets available.
- If any **HANDICAPPED SEATING** is required, then notify the sponsors **by May 31st.**
- Allow yourself and the graduate plenty of time to arrive at school.
- Auditorium doors will **open at 6 p.m.** for commencement seating.
- Seats MAY NOT BE SAVED.
- ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS MUST BE SEATED BY 6:50 P.M. Aisles and doorways of the auditorium must be clear at this time. We understand that everyone is excited, but help us by controlling your family and friends. We want commencement to be a special day for each graduate.Do not stand or walk in the aisles during the processional. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated in advance!
- **COMMENCEMENT IS FINISHED ONCE EVERY GRADUATE HAS EXITED THE AUDITORIUM.** Do not attempt to walk between the graduates. Allow them to exit the auditorium! The graduates will proceed directly to the front offices so that they can receive their official diplomas. Your graduate will meet you after he or she has checked out of the office.

- ALLOW YOURSELF PLENTY OF TIME.
- SENIORS <u>ARE NOT</u> PERMITTED IN THE AUDITORIUM PRIOR TO THE PROCESSIONAL!
- SENIORS ARE TO REPORT DIRECTLY TO ROOM 125 (Rohm) or ROOM 127 (Lindey) BY 6:20. NO SENIOR SHOULD BE IN FRONT OF THE AUDITORIUM...NO SOCIALIZING IN THE HALLS...GET TO WHERE YOU NEED TO BE WHEN YOU NEED TO BE THERE!
- YOU ARE TO DRESS APPROPRIATELY AS YOU DID ON SENIOR DAY AND AWARDS DAY...COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE...NO TENNIS SHOES OR FLIP FLOPS!
- STUDENTS NEED TO BRING ALL ITEMS WITH THEM...CAP, TASSEL, GOWN, HONOR CORDS...IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO HAVE EVERYTHING THAT YOU NEED ORGANIZED BY THE NIGHT BEFORE.
- NO FOOD OR DRINKS!! THERE WILL BE WATER IN THE ROOMS.
- THE SPONSORS HAVE NO EXTRA PARTS TO THE CAPS AND GOWNS...IF YOU ARE MISSING AN ITEM THEN TRY TO CONTACT A GRADUATE FROM A PREVIOUS YEAR...THERE ARE NO EXTRAS!
- CAPS MUST STAY ON YOUR HEAD DURING THE ENTIRE PROGRAM. MORTARBOARDS SHOULD BE PARALLEL TO THE FLOOR (NOT TILTED) WITH TASSEL ON THE RIGHT.
- GIRLS...EITHER BOBBY PIN THE CAP TO YOUR HEAD AT HOME OR BRING THE NECESSARY ITEMS WITH YOU TO SCHOOL.
- GIVE ALL VALUABLES...PURSES, CAR KEYS, CAMERAS, ETC. ... TO A PARENT OR GUARDIAN...VALUABLES CAN NOT BE LOCKED UP...WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY STOLEN ITEMS!
- NO GUM!!!!!
- ALL FACULTY AND STUDENTS WILL BEGIN TO WALK AT 6:50 TO THE AUDITORIUM...WE DO NOT WAIT FOR ANYONE...**YES, WE WILL START WITHOUT YOU...**FACULTY WILL ENTER THE AUDITORIUM AT 6:57...FOLLOWED BY THE GRADUATES.
- REMEMBER...YOU WILL RECEIVE A BLANK DIPLOMA AT COMMENCEMENT...AFTER THE CEREMONY, YOU WILL PROCEED UP THE RAMP TOWARD THE OFFICE...YOU MAY THEN PICK UP YOUR DIPLOMA IN THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE...ALL DEBTS AND/OR DISCIPLINES MUST BE CLEARED BY THE OFFICE BEFORE YOU WILL BE GIVEN YOUR DIPLOMA.
