Your child must complete the reading assignments and complete the assigned project for his/her grade next school year 2022-2023. The two AR tests and the project will be the first grades recorded in Reading.

Rising 4th Grade:

Assigned Book: Charlotte's Web by E. B. White

"I don't want to die! Save me, somebody! Save me! One spring morning a little girl called Fern rescues a runt and names him Wilbur. But then Wilbur is sent to live on a farm where he meets Charlotte, a beautiful large grey spider. They become best friends and, when Wilbur is faced with the usual fate of nice fat little pigs, Charlotte must find a clever way to save him.

Individually Selected Book: Each 4th grader <u>must</u> choose and read <u>1 additional AR</u> <u>chapter book</u> that he/she has not read before, and the book must be on the student's AR level.

Students will take AR tests over both books by Thursday, August $12^{\rm th}$ and these test grades will be recorded in Reading.

Project: Students need to answer the questions on the next page about the <u>individually</u> <u>selected book</u>. (due August 12th)

**Please DO NOT read Where the Red Fern Grows.
