

Use of School Equipment or Property

School equipment or property may be made available to community groups and/or individuals for an educational, civic, or charitable purpose when:

1. The group borrowing the equipment agrees to accept responsibility, repairing or replacing any equipment damaged or lost while in its possession.
2. The equipment does not exceed \$1,500 in replacement value.
3. The equipment is in good condition.
4. The group will provide a competent operator for equipment loaned.
5. Borrowing the equipment will not affect the education process.

The Board reserves the right to deny use of equipment for non-school use.
