during JUNE 2024:

- ⇒ Earn one(1) ticket each time you visit SFPL from June 1, 2024 - July 27, 2024.
- ⇒ Have fun by tracking your reading time in JUNE & JULY with the Turtle Time Tracker. Shade in a section for every 20 minutes you get to spend reading something you enjoy!
- ⇒ Read your way through the different countries in your Travel Log and participate other activities and programs in the library and on the SFPL website to earn tickets and more chances to for rewards!
- ⇒ Earn one(1) ticket per country "visited" in your Travel Log when you turn it in the week of June 24 -29, or the week of July 22 -27, 2024.
- ⇒ Earn one(1) ticket when you turn in this completed **JUNE** Travel Trivia by June 27, 2024. *The JULY version will be available upon request July 1 -14, 2024 at the SFPL front desk.*
- ⇒ Earn a ticket when you turn in your Turtle Time Tracker anytime before July 27, 2024 at 12PM. *Summer reading materials turned in **after** the week of July 22, 2024 -July 27, 2024 **will not** earn reward tickets.*
- ⇒ Use the tickets you earn to "purchase" SFPL Summer Reading reward items.
