Dumas Wesley Community Center Summer Recreation Program June 7 - July 29, 2022 / Monday-Friday 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM Registration Dates: April 4 – May 9, 2022

Criteria:

- Parent/guardian must reside or work in the 36607 or 36617 zip code. Limited space is available for residents living outside preferred zip code.
- Must have proof of child's age (birth certificate, blue card, etc.)
- Must have proof of residence or employment in the 36607 or 36617 zip codes (recent utility bill or current paycheck stub)
- Participants must be between the ages of 6-15

Dates Closed: Summer programming will be closed on <u>Monday, July 4</u>th in observation of Independence Day. The Summer Recreation program will also be closed <u>July 18-22</u> for the Camp Blue Lake trip in Andalusia, AL (see accompanying Blue Lake registration form for details).

Lunch: Feeding the Gulf Coast will be providing lunch Mon – Fri. Please let us know if your child has food allergies. Children may bring a lunch, if preferred.

Daily Schedule: The summer program operates Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Children need to arrive on time every day. **Parents you must escort your children to the atrium doors and check them in every morning**. Please make sure your child eats breakfast each morning, as **we do NOT serve breakfast**. A weekly newsletter will go home with your child every Friday. This newsletter will inform you of activities and reminders for the following week. The newsletter is essential and needs to be read carefully so that your child is prepared. In the afternoon, parents need to pick up their children at the atrium doors. We will not allow children to go outside without a parent/guardian.

Field Trips: On days we have a field trip planned, your child must arrive on time! We will not hold the bus or come back to the center if you are late. Unfortunately, we do not have the staff to watch children that do not want to participate. Also, children cannot be dropped off at the field trip site. They must ride the bus to be a part of the trip.

Pick up/Drop off: Parents are responsible for dropping off and picking up their children on time. Children must not arrive before 8:00 AM unless otherwise instructed. Doors will open at 8:00AM. Cut off time to drop off kids in the morning is 8:30AM.

Late Fee: Summer Rec ends promptly at 3 PM. Children MUST be picked up on time. A \$15.00 late fee will be charged for *each* child picked up after 3PM. An additional \$15.00 fee will be charged each additional 15 minutes late. Late pick up fees are assessed on the same day you are late and are due upon

pick up before you child can return for their next scheduled day. If you are running late, please call our front office at 251-479-0649.

Dumas Wesley Bus & Van Rules:

The bus driver is in <u>CHARGE</u> and shall be respected at all times!

- 1. Students **must** talk softly
- 2. Students **must** remain seated at all times.
- 3. Students **must** keep their body parts out of the aisle and keep all body parts to themselves and out of the windows.
- 4. Students shall <u>NOT</u> use profane language.
- 5. Students shall <u>NOT</u> fight, scuffle or talk loudly.
- 6. Students shall **<u>NOT</u>** throw anything out of the windows.
- 7. No electronic devices (cell phones, pagers, games, etc.) allowed on the bus at any time.

Two verbal warnings will be given to each student. After their second warnings, they will automatically be suspended from riding the bus. The bus driver and staff have the right to suspend a student from the bus at any time if the offense exceeds a warning!

Disciplinary Rules:

Dumas Wesley Community Center has a <u>zero-tolerance policy</u> for bullying or disrespectful behavior towards staff, peers, guests and children attending the summer program. We will not tolerate fighting, teasing or any other inappropriate behavior during summer recreation hours. If your child is acting out inappropriately, he or she may be subject to a write-up. If the child has to be written up, a parent will be notified at the end of the day regarding the incident, and will be given a copy of the infraction.

The Director may expel a child for justified reasons without warning or write up. If your child is expelled, their parent will be contacted immediately. If they are dismissed, registration fees will not be refunded.

Additional Summer Recreation Rules:

Tennis shoes are required. Parents, please bring an extra set of clothing for children 6-7 years old. Accidents do happen, and we do not have extra clothes for those occasions.

No short shorts, skirts, or clothing with foul language or images is permitted. All children are required to wear a belt. We do not allow sagging pants or shorts. If children continue to disobey the dress code, they may be sent home. Please make sure your children wear shoes that are adequate to run and play in and that your child is prepared every day.

Electronics, fidgets and outside toys are not allowed during Summer Recreation. This includes MP3 players, cell phones, I Pads, etc. If your child is caught playing with an electronic device or outside toy, it will be taken and returned at the end of the day. We are not responsible for anything that is lost, stolen or broken.

On swim days, please make sure your child has their swimsuit on underneath their clothing. Don't forget their towel and an extra change of clothing. Please make sure you label all clothing/towels. Girls must wear one-piece suits only. *If your child does not want to swim, they do not have to swim, but will still have to pay the fee to get into the pool area.*

Please note: Summer Rec spots cannot be held if application is not completed in full, along with payment.
