**REAP** - We get a couple of recipients each year, so if you are a Catholic Order of Foresters member, your children are eligible. They can become a member for just \$25 (I believe) and they are eligible for scholarships for college as well as this program each year they are enrolled in RE.

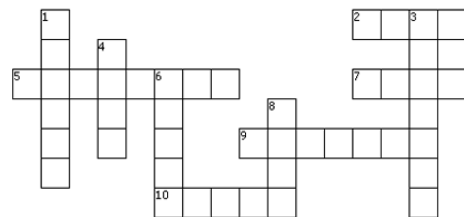
