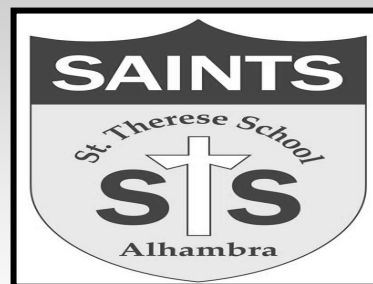

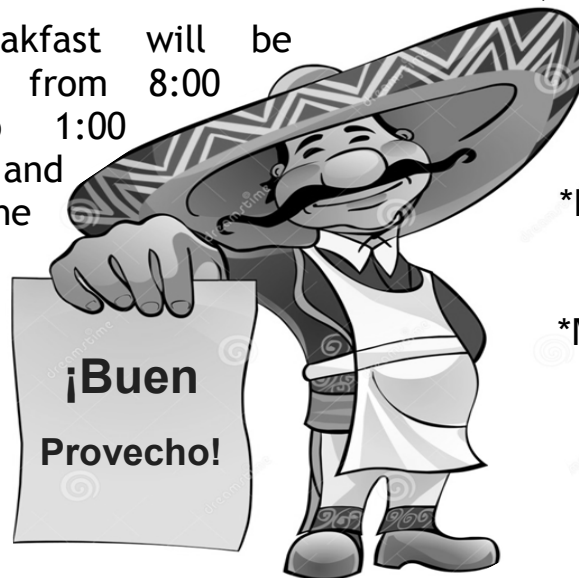

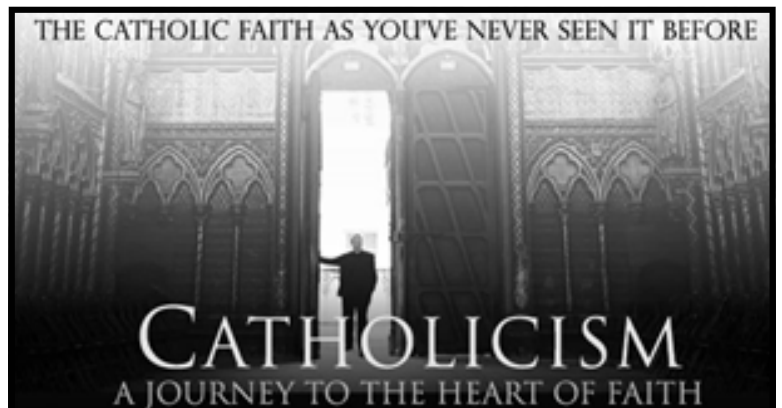
## HALLOWEEN "SAFE ZONE" TRUNK OR TREAT

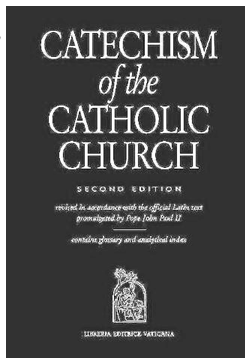

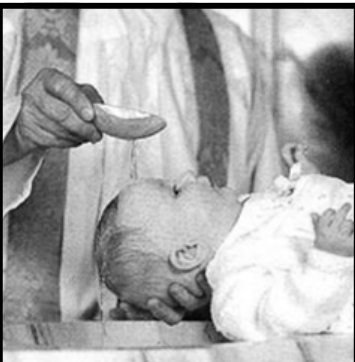
