Dear Parishioners,

We’ve received some clarification regarding the observance of All Saints Day, which falls on a Saturday this year. Because it falls on a Saturday, the Holy Day obligation is lifted, and therefore it cannot be celebrated the evening before.

Due to the regularly scheduled noon and evening Masses that day, I will not be adding an additional Mass. We will celebrate one All Saints Day Mass at noon at the Convent.

On Saturday evening and Sunday, we will celebrate All Souls Day. Our annual Memorial Mass for all the faithful departed will take place at the 8:30 am Mass on Sunday, November 2, followed by a freewill Knights of Columbus breakfast.

As we enter this season when the Church turns her attention to the Last Things—death, judgment, heaven, and hell, I begin this year’s reflections with a heartfelt thank you to all who care for our cemeteries.

This includes Martin and Laura, Caren and Dan, and Dan Grimes, who handle the sale and marking of graves and maintain our records, as well as the mowers and groundskeepers who keep our cemeteries so well cared for. With the abundant rainfall this year, it required even more work than usual, and your dedication has not gone unnoticed.

We are blessed with three beautiful cemeteries under our AFC’s care. They are not only practical places for the burial of our loved ones but also sacred spaces of remembrance and prayer—places that gently remind us of our own mortality and the hope of eternal life. It brings me great joy to see so many visiting and praying for loved ones at these holy grounds.

I encourage you to take part in the indulgence granted for visiting cemeteries beginning Saturday and continuing for one week. (As a reminder, the usual conditions apply: sacramental confession within a week, reception of Holy Communion, detachment from sin, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.)

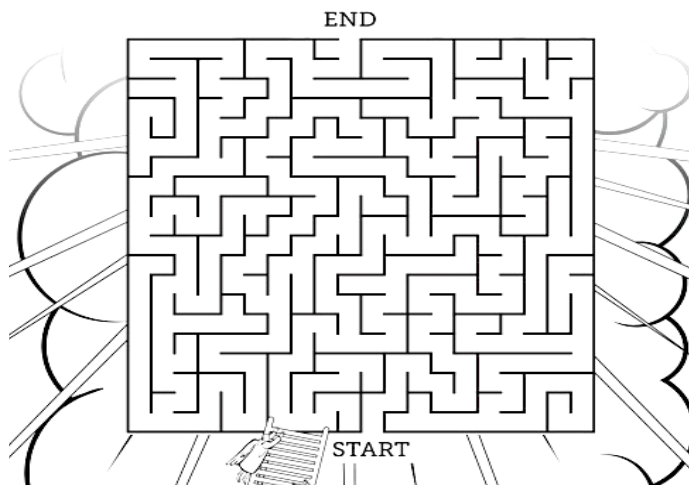
