CONGRATULATIONS!

Salem High School was recognized at the 2024 Jobs for America's Graduates National Training Seminar in Las Vegas, Nevada for exceeding the outcome standards for the follow-up class of 2023.



CONTACT RATE

JVG specialists are tasked with contacting graduates of the previous year to record their outcomes every month for one year after graduation. Exceeding the JAG standard of 95% is often difficult but is a testament to the relationships JVG specialists develop with participants of the program.

GRADUATION RATE

The graduation rate is determined by the number of JVG senior participants who complete the requirements of earning a high school diploma, GED, or equivalent.

EMPLOYMENT RATE

The employment rate is calculated by combining the number of participants that are working either part-time or full-time after graduation.

FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT

JAG expects that 60% of the participants working be employed for 30 or more hours per week.

POSITIVE OUTCOME RATE

The positive outcome rate comprises the number of graduates who go on to military service, enroll in 2 or 4-year post-secondary training, attain an industry-standard certification, or directly enter the workforce after high school.

FURTHER EDUCATION RATE

Further education refers to current enrollment in a post-secondary program and/or the attainment of an industry-standard credential either during or after the high-school experience.
