#### Reminders

- Growth and Maturity
- Discipline: Last year seniors had 33 referrals, right now we have 28.
  - Almost 50 fewer referrals throughout the school. (155 last year, 107 now)

# **Attendance Policy**

- Students in grades 9-12 who have accumulated more than (5) unexcused absences will be in jeopardy of not receiving credits
- Every absence will require an independent excuse
  - Ex. If you have the flu and are out of school 3 days, you must turn in an excuse for each day.

# Honor and Superior Honor **Graduates**

- Honor Graduates
  - 90 or better cumulative average – Advanced Academic Pathway
- **Superior Honor Graduates**
- 95 or better cumulative average
  - - Requirements
      - Earn four credits in one academic subject area
      - One of those credits must be an AP course or a DE course
      - Plus two credits of Foreign Language

### Differences in GPAs

- HOPE GPA is calculated by using Core Academics plus Foreign Language
  - Math, Science, Social Studies, English and Foreign Language
  - Electives **DO NOT** count
  - CTAE course that count as a science credit is calculated into your HOPE
     GPA
  - Any extra points that are added by the school AP(5), DE(4), Honors(3) are deducted (.5 added back for DE & AP)
  - See your HOPE GPA through your GAFutures account

- High School GPA is calculated using all types of credits
- Math, Science, Social
   Studies, English and
   Foreign Language
- Electives DO count

# **HOPE Scholarship**

- Must have a 3.0 Hope GPA at graduation to be eligible for Hope Scholarship.
- Hope GPA of 3.7 for Zell Miller and score at least 1200 on SAT in one test session or 26 composite on ACT; Valedictorian and Salutatorian are automatically Zell Miller recipients
- HOPE Career GRANT: high school diploma and maintain 2.0

# SAT, ACT & ASVAB Test Prep Resources

- Khan Academy is an online test prep resource that is free for SAT
- SAT and ACT Prep Materials are also available in the library
- Edmentum (come to the CPC to sign up)

### **STAR Student**

- Take the two-part SAT on any national testing date.
- Score highest on any single test date (scores may not be combined from two or more test dates).
- At the end of Junior year, based on GPA, must be in the top 10% of the class.
- If the student with the highest SAT score does not meet the top 10 criterion, the student with the next highest SAT score who does meet the criterion becomes the nominee.
- Last Test Date 11/8/2025; Registration deadline is 10/24

# **College Applications Process**

- Submit applications
  - All colleges have different deadlines
  - Submission Portals:
    - CommonApp; GaFutures; college-specific
  - Request an unofficial transcript
  - May need a Letter of Recommendation
    - Fill out & submit a Senior Brag Sheet google form
- Immunizations
  - Required form
  - May have to get shots

- Proof of Residence
  - Driver's license
- Apply for housing
- Send a final official high school transcript.
  - After graduation
  - Must let Registrar know where to send it.
  - Request for DE transcripts to be sent to your college choice(s)

### GEORGIA MATCH Program

- •In October, GSFC mails a GEORGIA MATCH letter to each high school senior attending a public or private high school in Georgia.
- •The letter identifies all the USG & TCSG colleges that the student is academically qualified to attend based on their HOPE GPA as of 11th grade.

- Required Documentation
  - Scholarship Application
  - College letter of Acceptance
  - Two community letters of recommendation
  - Two teacher recommendation forms
  - Transcript WITH SAT or ACT scores

- Additional Requirements
  - Completed FAFSA
  - Cumulative GPA of 2.5
  - Jan 30th Local scholarship application posted online
  - March 2nd Applications due to CPC

# The Valdosta Sullivan Scholars Program

- Cohort program for teacher education at VSU
- Email your counselor for more information

- Qualifications:
  - Be in 12th grade in a rural Georgia high school
  - Qualify for PELL (Must have FAFSA on file with VSU)
- Be HOPE Eligible (4 rigor courses and 3.0 or higher HOPE GPA) or on track to become HOPE eligible by high school graduation
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have a passion for becoming a teacher

### **Scholastic Jackets**

- To earn a Scholastic Jacket, students must have a 90 cumulative average through the first semester of their senior year.
- Earning a jacket does <u>not</u> automatically qualify you as an honor graduate.
- If you meet this criteria you will be notified by the CPC in January.
