### Fees for Late Pick Up at End of School Day

Parents are responsible to pick children up on time at the end of the school day. Carline is from 2:55-3:25. The following late fees are in effect for students picked up after 3:25:

- 3:30-4:00, \$15 per child for the first half-hour (*or after the end of carline to 4:00 pm*)
  - 4:00-4:30, \$20 per child for the second half-hour
  - 4:30 or later, \$20 per child per every additional half-hour
  - *On early dismissal days, late charges start at 2:00 p.m.*
