

REOPENING PLAN 2021-2022

July 22, 2021

From Atkinson County Superintendent of Schools, Bob Brown:

Following one year of schools operating with multiple methods of instruction (Face-to-Face and Virtual) due to the worldwide Pandemic, the Atkinson County School District (ACSD) now presents a plan to reopen schools for the 2022 academic year. With this document, Atkinson County School District intends to provide the information and guidance needed to help the community, families, students, and staff understand the aspects of the reopening and operation of District schools under current public health conditions.

Atkinson County School District's reopening school plan proposes full inperson instruction, five days per week for the 2021-2022 school year.

All programs and services offered by the District will be available to students and families. In addition, any students who may be quarantined due to COVID-19 or who must remain at home for any health-related reason during the 2021-2022 school year will have access to academic content for short term absences (approximately two weeks or less). Access to school curriculum and classroom activities will be through District provided technology including support for internet connectivity. Only if and when governmental authorities close schools or limit school operations, a combination of distance education and in-person instruction, or a Hybrid Model may be implemented in response to a universal, public health threat or condition.

First Day of School for Students: Schools will reopen for the 2021-2022 school year on **August 2, 2021** for students in grades Pre-K-12.

The Atkinson County School System will follow guidance from the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH), and Georgia Department ofEducation (GaDOE). The information below summarizes the steps we are taking to safely open school as scheduled.

Only 1 adult may accompany their child(ren) to class. During the 2nd week of school - Only Parents of Pre-K and Kindergarten students may walk their child to class; parents cannot go into the classroom, however. Only 1 adult may accompany their child(ren) to class. Beginning the 3rd week of school - NO parents will be allowed to walk their child(ren) into school. 				
School Arrival Time	• Students may enter the building at 7:10 or after. No students are allowed in the building prior to 7:10.

Cafeteria	 Breakfast will be served / eaten in the classroom. Lunch will be served in the cafeteria. Breakfast and lunch are served at NO CHARGE to students. 				
Communication	 Important Communication will be shared through Facebook, Infinite Campus, Atkinson County School System's district and school websites. 				
Extracurricular Activities/Athletics	 Athletics will follow GHSA recommendations. Extracurricular/Academic clubs will follow DPH and GaDOE guidelines. 				
Field Trips	Field trips will be allowed.				

Safe and Healthy Schools Procedures	 Parents should pre-screen students before sending them to school or bus stops each day. Any student with a measured temperature of 100.4 or higher or any COVID-19 symptoms should not be sent to school. They will be sent home if they come to school with symptoms. All classrooms will be supplied with hand sanitizer and disinfectant. Best practices for hand washing will be implemented. Custodial staff will be provided disinfecting equipment and supplies.

Student School Supplies	 All student school supplies will be provided by the Atkinson County Board of Education. Parents are asked to provided only personal items such as bookbags. For help in acquiring bookbags, contact Family Connection Director Jennife Brown. 	
Transportation	 Parents may opt to transport students. Bus students are encouraged to sit with family groups. Hand sanitizer will be available on all buses. 	
Visitor Procedures	 Visitors are allowed. Masks are optional. Video conferencing is also an option. 	
Water	 Water bottles are recommended. Water filling stations are located at each school. Water fountains have been turned off.
