## DISTRICT NOTIFICATION - August 31, 2022



Dear AWBLA Families:

**One new case of COVID-19 has been identified in connection with A. W. Brown Leadership Academy.** Out of an abundance of caution and respect for transparency, you are receiving this letter because your scholar may have been at school at the same time as an individual who was potentially capable of transmission. Safety measures were followed including wearing masks (optional), social distancing, and hand sanitizing. **Unless a campus administrator or the school nurse specifically talked with you about being a close contact, or you receive a close contact notification letter, you are NOT a close contact of the individual with COVID-19.**

Public health officials recommend the following guidance/precautions:

- **Monitor daily for ANY symptoms of COVID-19**, including fever, chills, fatigue, muscle aches, headache, diarrhea, vomiting, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, loss of sense of taste or smell, cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing. The intensity of symptoms can vary; some people who contract COVID-19 experience no symptoms, while others may become very ill.

If your scholar begins to experience any of these symptoms in a way that is not typical, we encourage you to contact your physician. Scholars may attend school if they are not experiencing symptoms. Rapid testing has resumed at your campus.

We will continue to watch our distance, wash our hands and/or use hand sanitizer often. We strongly encouraged wearing a mask, but it remains optional.
