Senior Awards Night is usually Tuesday night prior to graduation at 6:30 p.m. in the Commons. This event is for you and your parents. Parents of the Senior Class host this event by planning the dessert and decorating. Any parent interested in volunteering please see the office for details. Also, please tell the advisor how many parents, including you, will be attending that night. This is a formal occasion, please dress appropriately.

Pick up your cap and gown in the office the Monday before graduation. Please iron your gown because it WILL be <u>very</u> wrinkled.

You must completely check out by 3 p.m. on the Thursday before graduation. Pay any and all fees by this time (the earlier the better). If you have any overdue books, be sure to turn them into the library ASAP. If you have any unfinished business, you will not be able to check out, and if you don't check out, you can't practice. If you do not attend graduation practice, you will not be allowed to participate in Saturday's commencement exercises.

Graduation rehearsal begins promptly at 8:30 a.m. on the Friday before graduation. It is important to be on time for this, because several people will be asked to help out this morning. You will need to bring your **cap and gown** for newspaper photos. The principal and a school board representative may be there to rehearse, as well as Knappa's gold gowns. **Your walking partners will be assigned on this morning.** Please come prepared to cooperate. The better prepared you are, the better the graduation ceremony goes. This is the most important event of your high school career and many eyes will be on you and your success that night. **Congratulations!**
