The 1st nine weeks for first grade is an adjustment period. Grading Categories and Weights

30% Class Participation- (Ex. Math facts, Review/ practice work, daily class work, etc.)

40% Formative Assessments- (Ex. Spelling tests, and checking for understanding, quizzes, etc.)

30% Summative Assessments- (Ex. Writing prompts, projects, unit tests, etc.)

Elementary Related Arts:

E- Excellent (100%-80%)

S- Satisfactory (79% - 60%)

U- Unsatisfactory (59% or below)
