New Tdap Cocoon Program

Are you caring for a newborn?

CCHD is offering the Tdap vaccine at no cost for residents over the age of 19, who care for a newborn under the age of one.

Why receive a Tdap vaccine?

Newborns do not yet have fully developed immune systems, making them particularly vulnerable to pertussis (P in Tdap) infection.

The Tdap vaccine offers protection from three serious diseases: Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (whooping cough).

All U.S. households can soon order up to four no cost COVID-19 at-home tests via <u>COVIDtests.gov.</u>

Testing kits will be mailed once the federal program restarts in late September.
