In the spring of each school year, school districts across the state of Missouri are required to administer state assessments for students in grades 3-8 and designated subject areas at the High School level. All students enrolled in the Riverview Gardens School District that meet the guidelines for state testing are required to take the required assessments. The state of Missouri has a no opt-out policy, and the district expects all students to participate in all district or statewide assessments. A full calendar of the required assessments can be found in the Assessment Handbook starting on page 13.

Assessment results for state testing will be available to parents/guardians within 30 days once the district receives them. If they are not disseminated to parents/guardians during this time, each school will notify parents/guardians when they will be available. In most cases, this will occur at the end of the first quarter during parent/teacher conferences.
