CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by the Board President, S. Baylor-Schmidt. A motion was made by M. Bibler and seconded by M. Urish to approve the agenda. Voice vote showed 7 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

Superintendent Schurman noted that this resolution must be approved for our district to participate in future short term pooled investment opportunities. On occasion they offer 1 month certificate of deposits at attractive interest rates (4.5% APR) most recently. It provides us additional opportunities to earn interest on our deposits and the investment program is approved for school districts.

We start Monday, August 14, 2023, with two days of teacher's institute and the students' first day is Wednesday, August 16, 2023. Christmas Break is December 23-January 8, 2024.
