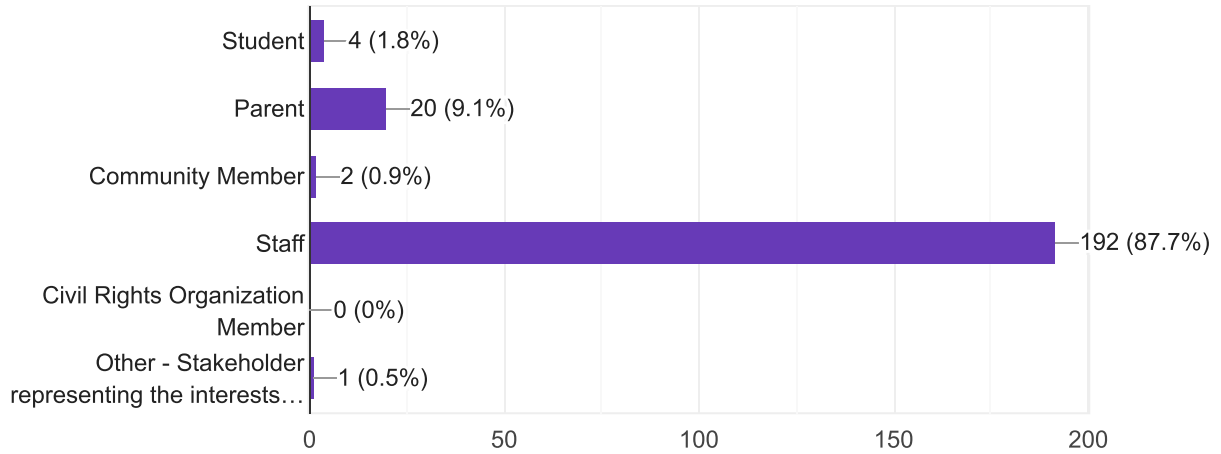

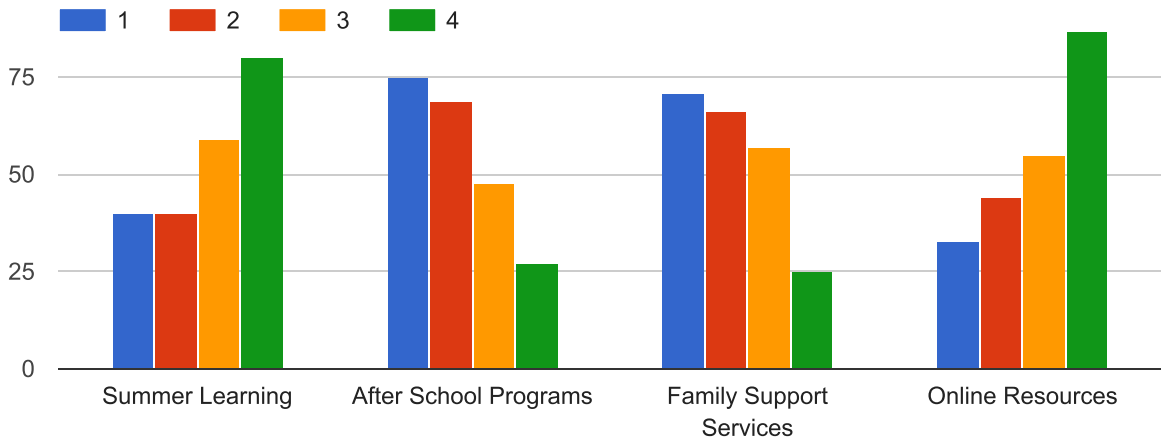

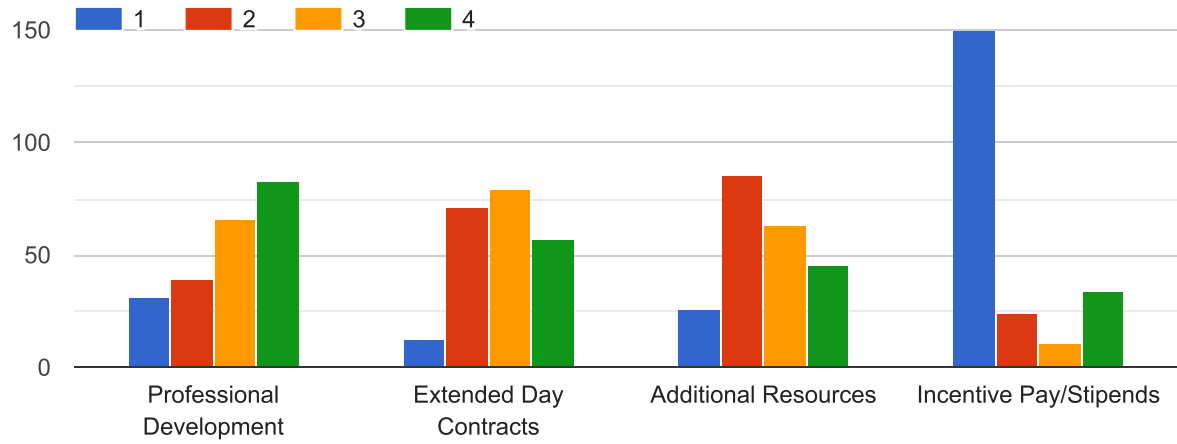

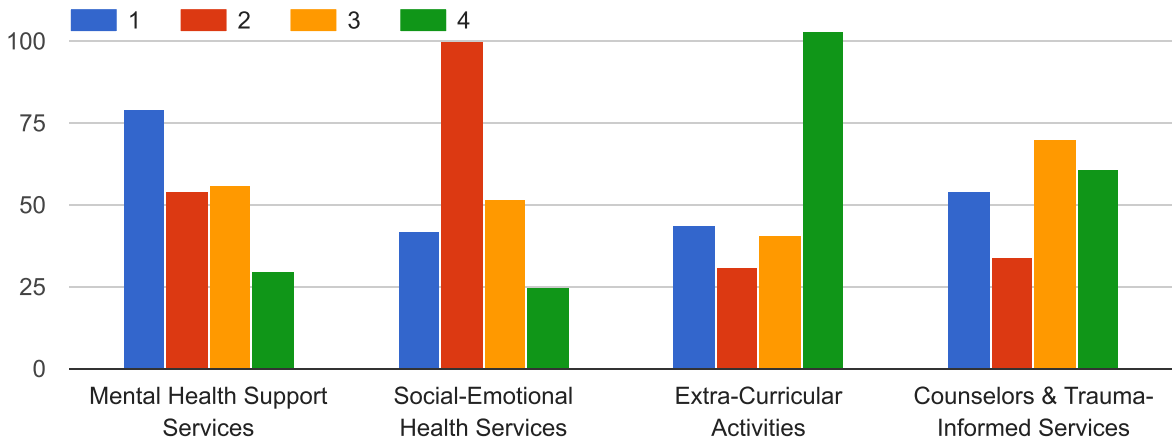
STUDENT LEARNING: (Please rank the items to address student learning loss, with #1 being the most impactful)



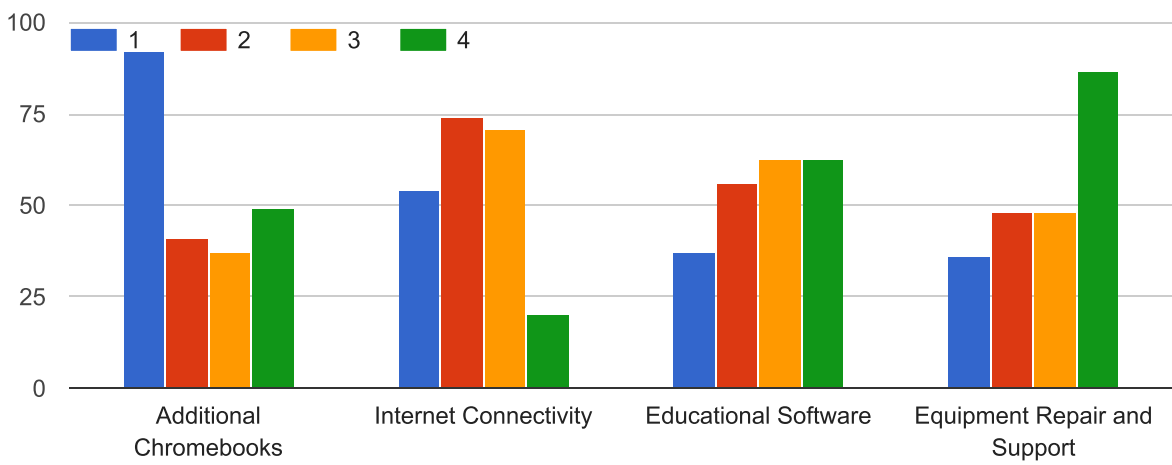

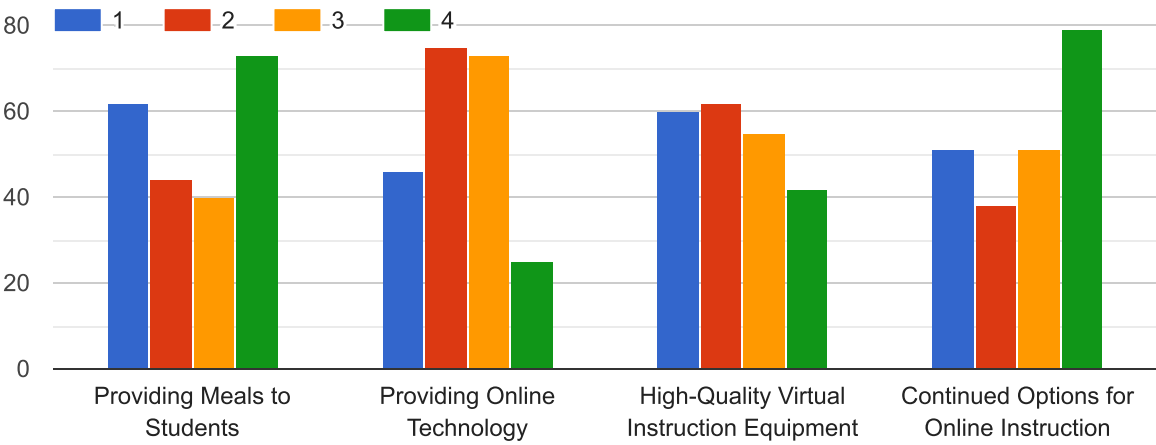

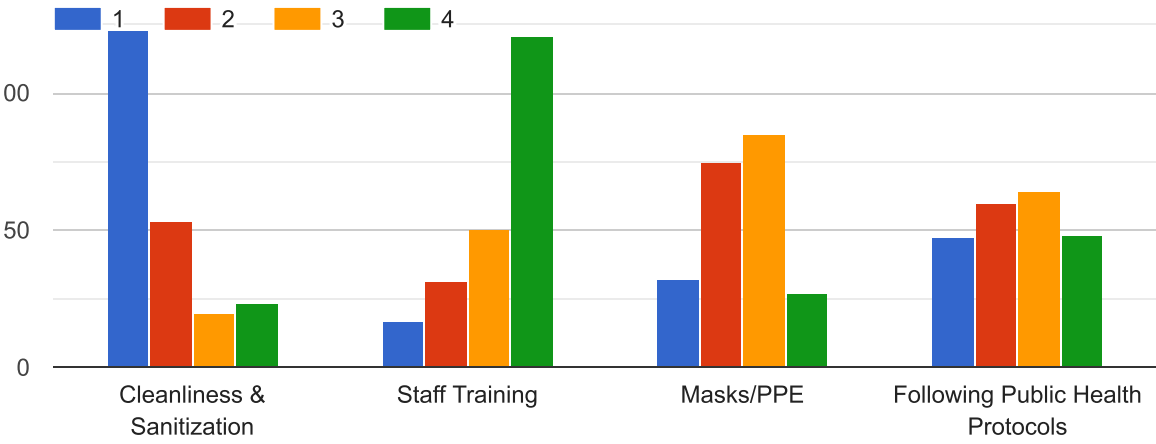

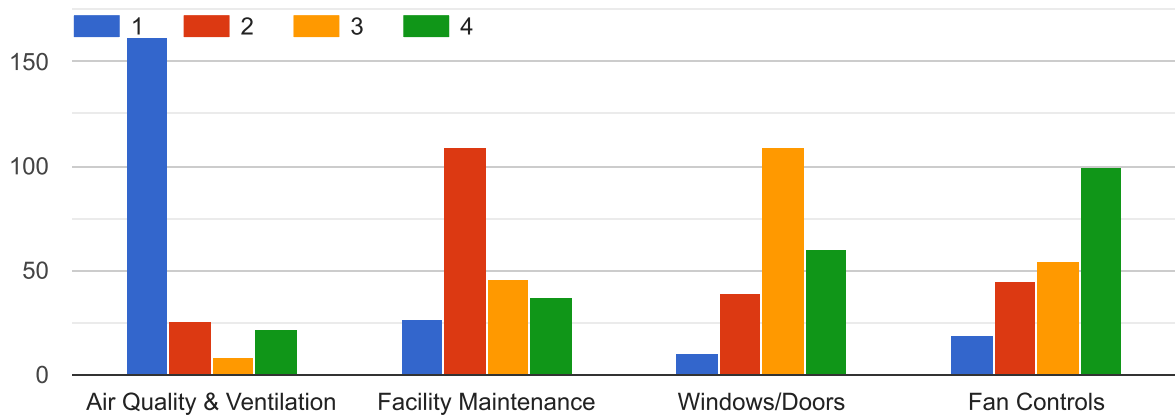
LONG-TERM EMERGENCY CLOSURES: (In event of long-term closures, RGSD would benefit most from; with No. 1 showing the greatest benefit)
