Students are participating in games, dances, and clubs in higher numbers than in previous years. Enrollment is high and the old gym was packed for Pep Rallies, but less students opted to sit out. Dr. Rizer continues to encourage students to get involved in school activities and optimize their high school experience.
  - b. Homecoming Dance had the most tickets sold in many years. Over 1000 tickets sold.
  - c. Athletics: HCHS Softball and Volleyball are so far undefeated in the region. Football performance is the best in 5 years. Mrs. Van Buskirk recounted how some people attending the football game were surprised about the app-only ticket purchase at the gate. Dr. Rizer explained that due to a trend towards cashless ticket purchase, an increase in games attendance and the expectation for transparency and accountability, tickets sales are moving exclusively towards the Go Fan App.
  - d. Mrs. Van Buskirk asked about the Prom and Graduation dates. Prom will be on April the 22nd and Graduation on Friday, May 26th at 4pm. This year, HCHS will have the earliest graduation time. Dr. Rizer will send out the list of Important dates for the 2022-2023 school year.
