#### Curriculum and Instruction

1. Agreement of affiliation-National Academy Foundation, Academy of Hospitality and Tourism, Trinity High School

The agreement of affiliation between National Academy Foundation (NAF) and public schools is renewed every year by each participating academy. On May 30, 2014, Trinity High School was accepted by NAF to be in the "Year of Planning Cohort" for the 2014-2015 school year. The school desires to pilot, for the district, an Academy of Hospitality and Tourism. The Academy of Hospitality and Tourism will launch at Trinity High School in the 2015-2016 school year. The initial startup costs for the Academy of Hospitality and Tourism will be covered through their launch in 2015-2016 from the Career and Technical Education budget. This budget and affiliation with NAF, which is a strategy in the local plan to improve the scope and sequence of the Career and Technical Education program in the Randolph County School System, have both been accepted by the Department of Public Instruction as part of the 2014-2015 CTE Local Planning System.

After the 2015-2016 launch, the Academy will be self-sustaining through their established advisory board. The Career and Technical Education Department will continue to assist with affiliation costs for the NAF which is \$1,000.00 per year. Upon successful launch of a career-themed Academy in the district, this program could be expanded to include other schools where there is interest in the program or similar Academy programs. The superintendent stated this is based on interest and numbers of students. Also, this program is part of the Career and Technical Education (CTE) program. The CTE program has increased involvement across the state.

Catherine Berry, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, presented the 2014-2015 Memorandum of Understanding for the board's approval. The superintendent shared the memorandum of understanding is the same as previous years with the exception of the change of the superintendent's name on the signature page. A question was asked regarding the name of the liaison. Ms. Nancy Cross from Randolph Early College High School is the liaison. After review, Matthew Lambeth made a motion to approve the 2014-2015 Memorandum of Understanding

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between Randolph Community College and Randolph County School System for Randolph Early College High School; motion was seconded by Gary Mason and the motion passed unanimously.

Catherine Berry reviewed the first reading of the recommended revisions to Board Policies. After review, Matthew Lambeth moved to approve the revisions as presented; motion was seconded by Tommy McDonald and the motion passed 7-0.

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent for Operations, presented a recommendation for a lunch price increase of 10 cents based on requirements from USDA (Paid Lunch Equity Tool). He stated this requirement is an effort by the USDA to keep paid lunch prices in line with free reimbursements and plate costs. Over time, meal prices have had gradual increases in order to be fair to parents and students. The cost to Randolph County School System is \$3.45 for each plate we serve. The free rate reimbursement gets us closer to the \$3.45 cost. Surrounding counties are currently at these recommended prices and higher (up to \$2.55). Mr. Trotter stated the current child nutrition fund balance is \$5.4 million, which is a drop of one million from May of 2013. Child nutrition fund balance is used to balance the child nutrition budget. He commended the child nutrition department for their hard work and efforts in monitoring costs. There was also discussion regarding the universal breakfast program. Each school will have the universal breakfast program for the upcoming school year. In conclusion, Mr. Trotter stated that Randolph County School System's free/reduced rate is currently 56%. Following discussion, Tracy Boyles moved to approve the 2014-2015 lunch price increase of 10 cent as presented. Gary Cook seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Todd Cutler moved that the Randolph County Board of Education enters into closed session to preserve the attorney-client privilege and to discuss confidential personnel matters protected by state law as provided in North Carolina General Statute §143-318.11. The motion was seconded by Gary Cook. Motion passed unanimously.
