To register online:

1. Sign into your [parent portal account](#) using your current username and password.
 - a. If you forgot either of these, you can hit the "Forgot Username" or "Forgot Password" option.
2. Once you are logged in, begin registration. **You will not have to link your student.** You should see their picture on the login screen.
3. If you can see your child's name, but the "Begin Registration" button isn't there, **it means that you've used another email to create the account or there isn't an email on the account.** Please contact your student's campus, and we can get it corrected for you.
