#### **School Meals**

Meals (breakfast and lunch) will be served at school. We will be returning to normal meal charges which were adopted by the Hankinson Public School Board during their annual meeting in July.

## **Special Education**

The Hankinson Public School will work in conjunction and collaboration with the South Valley Special Education Unit, to ensure that educational decisions for students with individual education plans will be made on an individual basis and in compliance with the IDEA and NDDPI. The learning environment, services, and accommodations for students with disabilities will be determined through the student's IEP team.

## Transportation

The Hankinson Public School will continue to provide transportation services for students. These services will include rural routes as well as some limited stops within the community.

#### Mental Health

The Hankinson Public School will continue to prioritize the mental health needs of our students and staff during the 2024-2025 school year. Counseling services are available five days each week, providing access to mental health services for all students. The counselor will also provide opportunities for social and emotional learning, peer support groups, and small group services.
