During the academic year, each school conducts a minimum of: 3 school evacuation drills to address and prepare students and school personnel for fire incidents (1 of which must involve the participation of the fire department/district); 1 bus evacuation drill (accounted for in the district's curriculum); 1 severe weather and shelter in place drill to address and prepare students and school personnel for possible tornado incidents; and 1 law enforcement lockdown drill with the participation of law enforcement. The law enforcement lockdown drill must be conducted no later than 90 days after the first day of each school year and the district must comply with all of the requirements of Public Act 102-0395 related to the administration of this drill and the treatment of students who do not participate in the this drill
