Description	The November session of the New Teacher Academy will be divided into two topics. First, our new teachers will receive an overview of important "need-to-knows" with respect to educating students with disabilities. This will focus both on compliance issues as well as best practices to ensure a quality education for all. In the 2 nd half of this session, the subject will shift to an introductory presentation on artificial intelligence. Participants will learn some basics about how chatbots (like ChatGPT) work, helping them to better understand how and when it might be appropriate to use such tools in their planning. Some time will also be devoted to highlight a couple of commonly used AI tools that teachers can begin using right away.
