CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN

Elmore County Schools Policy: The Teachers' Bill of Rights requires every teacher to have an approved classroom management plan and affords teachers the right to exclude disruptive students from their classrooms in certain circumstances. The purpose of this policy is to outline the standards applicable to the development and approval of required classroom management plans; the standards applicable to the exclusion of a student from the classroom by a teacher; and the appeal process available to a teacher if a student is returned to the classroom by the principal. Removal of a student should never be the first option.

Entering the Classroom

- Pick up any papers by the door.
- If needed, get a pencil from the drawer.
- Get a calculator, if needed for unit.
- Sit in your assigned seat and get out your pencil.
- · Begin working on Warm-Up.

Leaving the Classroom

- You MUST have permission.
- You MUST have a pass.
- When traveling as a class, students are expected to be in a quiet single file line.

Turning in Work

- All assignments should be turned in completed on time and with EFFORT!
- Make sure your first and last name and class period are on your paper.

Rules & Expectations

- Enter class quietly and on time.
- 2. Bring all supplies to class each day.
- 3. Raise your hand to ask questions.
- 4. Participate!!
- 5. Turn in assignments on time.
- 6. Be polite and respectful to everyone.
- Keep hands, feet, and other body parts as well as objects to yourself.
- Inappropriate behavior and/or language will not be tolerated.

Electronics

. Cell Phones & Smart Watches are NOT allowed on or out.
They must be off and in your bookbag — not your back pocket or your jacket!
Chromebooks may only be used with teacher permission.

This is per the FOCUS aCT and school rules.

Puring Class

- Raise your hand if you have a question.
- Stay in your assigned seat during notes, quizzes, & tests unless you have permission to do otherwise.
- Show Respect to everyone, including yourself. REMEMBER, YOU CAN DO MATH!
- Sit up in your desk correctly don't put your head down or slide down in your seat.
- There is NO talking during quizzes or tests. Cheating will result in a ZERO on the assignment.

Dismissal

- I dismiss the class, not the bell.
- Clean up your desk area.
- Trash in the trash cans.
- Make sure Exit Ticket is turned in.
- Wait for/walk to your next class in a quiet single file line.
