## **Block Scheduling**

DeSoto County high schools follow what is known as block scheduling or sometimes referred to 4 x 4 block scheduling. Students will progress through a series of state required courses and electives during their four years of high school. Most courses will last an entire semester, and the student will earn one (1) credit for each semester course when successfully passed. There are elective courses that are only a half (1/2) credit and will last for nine weeks. Credit is also awarded upon successful completion of the course. Classes will last 94 minutes for each block.

## **RESTRICTED PRIVILEGE LIST (RPL)**

The following behaviors may result in the loss of all extracurricular privileges at LCHS:

- 9 or more days of ALC
- Suspended from LCHS for 1 or more days
- Assignment to DCAC or JDC
- Arrested off campus

Example: Luke is a senior member of the LCHS football team, however, he was suspended from LCHS due to flagrant insubordination. According to the guidelines of the RPL LIST, Luke is no longer a member of the football team, cannot participate in another sport, cannot attend any school functions/activities at or away from LCHS, and will not be able to attend PROM.

The RPL List will be shared with all staff weekly and will be updated by administration.



## **9<sup>th</sup> Grade \$25 Device Fee Payment and Handout**

1. Scan the QR code below to pull up the website to pay the \$25 fee.



2. Enter your student's MSIS number or lunch number.
3. Enter payment information.
4. Receive your receipt.
5. The school will be notified. Please allow 24 to 48 hours for payment to show within the LCHS system.

9<sup>th</sup> grader students who have paid his/her fee will begin receiving devices the first full week of school beginning on Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup>.

If you would like to pay your student's fee by check or cash tonight, you may do so in the library.



### **Final Reminders**
