| Grade 4-5 TCAP (Pearson) | April 17 – May 2, 2023 | Summative assessment for students in Grades 4 & 5 given for ELA, Science, and Math. The Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program addresses the Tennessee state standards, and is intended to provide information regarding student achievement to educators, parents, and the public. TCAP is used to determine the level at which students meet content standards and to measure progress over time at the school and district levels. Students in grades 3-8 will be assessed in the spring in all content areas. The student score from TCAP will be calculated into the student's class average. The score on the TCAP will be 15% of the overall grade. | Required | Fall of 2023 |
| Grade 4-5 TCAP ALT (Pearson) MSAA Social Studies and Science | March 13-April 28, 2023 | Summative assessment for students in Grades 4 & 5 who qualify for alternative testing given for ELA, Science, and Math.The Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program addresses the Tennessee state standards, and is intended to provide information regarding student achievement to educators, parents, and the public. TCAP is used to determine the level at which students meet content standards and to measure progress over time at the school and district levels. Students in grades 3-8 will be assessed in the spring in all content areas. The student score from TCAP will be calculated into the student's class average. The score on the TCAP will be 15% of the overall grade. | Required | Fall of 2023 |
| CASE Assessments | Benchmark 1: Sep26- Oct 7 Benchmark 2: Dec 5-16 Benchmark 3: March 6-17 | Students in grades 4 & 5 will participate in CASE Benchmark assessments. CASE Benchmark Assessments are designed to gauge the academic progress of students and to provide timely feedback that can be used by teachers to guide instruction. The benchmark assessments, which are aligned to College- and Career-Ready Standards/Common Core State Standards (CCSS), & TNReady, provide valuable data regarding all students' knowledge of the standards. | Required | 4 weeks after each administration |
| ACCESS for ELS | Feb. 13 – April 3, 2023 | Students who are English learners. ACCESS for ELLs (ACCESS) is the collective name for WIDA's suite of summative English language proficiency assessments. ACCESS is taken annually by English language learners in Kindergarten through Grade 12 in WIDA Consortium member states. | Required | Fall 2023 |
| AIMSWEB+ | August 1 – September 30 or within 45 days from first day of school, whichever is earlier December 5 – February 3 April 10 – May 12 | Students at CCMS are screened to determine qualification of RTI2 status using AIMSWEB+. Students who do not perform at grade level on their fall iReady benchmark are tested for oral reading fluency and comprehension. Students are also assessed for math fluency. | Required | 2 Weeks |
| iReady Assessment | Fall/Winter/Spring | IReady is a benchmark assessment administered three times per year. The purpose of the assessment is to provide teachers with information regarding student growth and mastery of specific standards. This assessment is diagnostic. It provides questions based on student responses. The results from the assessments are analyzed and used to inform instruction for whole group, small group, and individual students. | Required | 24 hours |
