Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope that everyone had a relaxing summer. It was great welcoming the students back to school. To assist in ensuring the safety of our students all year, we kindly ask you to review the drop off and pick up procedures.

1. Cars should pull forward to the furthest stop sign placed on the sidewalk in front of the school. This allows ample space for numerous cars to pull up to the sidewalk. **Parents are to remain in their vehicle.**
2. Be mindful of the speed limits that are posted.
3. Please have students enter and exit the car from the passenger side (curb side) in the drop off and pick up line. With cars pulling around and pulling out, having students walk around the car to the driver's side could lead to a potentially dangerous situation.
4. School personnel are on duty each morning to facilitate the traffic flow. Staff supervision begins promptly at 8:05 am for CRS and 8:10 am for LLE. Please do not leave your child unescorted before that time. **If you drop off your child after 8:20 you must use the front main entrance.**
5. If you are late picking your child up (after 3:15) they will be waiting in the front of the school, however, it is important to be on time.

At LUTHER LEE EMERSON for those using Lenox Avenue, we ask that you remember it is a residential area and to drop off and pick up on the school side of the street only. **There are Police posted signs to inform you that NO U-TURNS are allowed on Lenox Avenue.** Additionally, do not park or make U-turns in residents' driveways. Please also remember not to park on the residential side or have children walk across the street as it is an active road and the students' safety is our utmost concern.

If exiting at LLE from Belmar onto Hardenburgh Avenue, you must turn right only, a NO LEFT TURN sign is posted.

LLE parents – You must communicate with your child whether they are to dismiss out the front of the school, in the back on Lenox Avenue or if they need to walk.

I thank you for working with us regarding the safety of your children.
