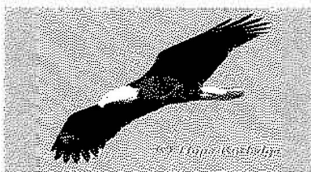

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION
APPLICANT DOES NOT HAVE TO HAVE ANY F.O.E. AFFILIATION

1. Applicant must use the official F.O.E. #2588 of East Tawas, Michigan form that has been dated and signed by the student, parent or guardian and Worthy President. Typewritten applications and statements are preferred over handwritten submissions and must be signed in instances.
2. Letter and statements must be originals on one side of a sheet of 8 ½ by 11 paper, dated, typed, if possible and signed by the author.
3. An OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT, certified by the school of the student's records from the beginning of the ninth grade to the due date of the application. These must be photocopied.
4. ACT or SAT test scores must be included, and these may be photocopies.
5. All materials must be properly bound within the application with staples on the left side.
6. The materials MUST be arranged in the order described below:
 - a) Application for Scholarship. Carefully plan a response to each item before typing the final draft. Using 1 for your freshman year of school and numbering the subsequent years 2, 3, 4 to identify the appropriate scholastic extracurricular and civic activities. Secure all required dates.
 - b) Statement of goals. The applicant shall prepare a statement of more than 250 but less than 300 words setting forth his/her vocational or professional goals and relate how past, present and future activities make the accomplishments of these goals probable. The applicant, by deed and circumstances must demonstrate his/her worthiness. Excess verbiage will detract from the statement. The additional criteria by which applicants will be judged are scholarship and leadership in school and non-school related activities. (i.e., church, scouts, youth organizations).
 - c) Current letters of recommendations from at least, but no more than three persons in authority from the high school by the applicant. The letters must be on official school letterhead, signed and dated by the author and include the title of the writer. The letters may cover the applicant's ability, work habits, leadership, personal and integrity.
 - d) Current letters of endorsement from two responsive non-school persons. These persons shall not be related to the applicant and should be capable of reporting the applicant's participation in non-school activities in terms of work, service, leadership, notable skills and outstanding recognition. It would be helpful to note how the writer came to know applicant.
7. The decision to grant or deny an award by the F.O.E. #2588 of East Tawas, Michigan is final.
8. After completing the application, make a photocopy for your records.
9. All application materials remain the property of the F.O.E. #2588 of East Tawas, Michigan and will not be returned.
