- Students should be using the AGENDA to find their assignments each day *especially if they were ABSENT during class (*opting out* or choosing failing grades is not permitted at CCRA and will result in Behavior Referrals with administrative intervention).
- <u>Students are expected to read the assigned texts outside of class</u> and be prepared to discuss or complete lessons/activities, with information from the text, during each class period.
 - The texts should take about 20 minutes AT MOST (many are 5-10 minute audio files).
 - Students are given <u>100 minutes of study hall per week</u> (Reaching Raiders).

- Audio versions of ALL texts can be found online with StudySync, but students are also encouraged to use any tool available to them to understand the text before class (including the Slide Guides in Google Classroom and scaffolds in StudySync).
- Grades will be primarily based on students' mastery of the cornerstones of English 1 rather than completion of specific assignments.
 - Cornerstones- 45% TN Framework of Standards for ENGLISH 1
 - ALL Questions answered on StudySync lessons & assessments affect this grade. Students get an average score for each standard, based on the classwork and assessment data, to show their level of understanding in that specific skill or concept. (*Descriptions can be found linked to each question as well as on StudentVue/ParentVue.)
 - Students are asked to review work for accuracy in class BEFORE submission.
 - Remediation for Cornerstones (due to failing or missing grades) is available during Reaching Raiders by request.
 - Common Assessments- 30% Weekly Quizzes, Unit Tests, & 20 Day Tests
 - Quizzes may be remediated for up to a maximum of 60%.
 - **Remediation** due to failing quizzes is available/encouraged EVERY quiz day.
 - It must be completed with 100% accuracy to replace failing quiz grades help is offered/encouraged to assist in meeting this expectation.
 - Effective Effort 25% <u>Weekly grade based on a rubric of skills found on Google</u> <u>Classroom</u>
 - Semester Exam/EOC- 15% Given at the end of each semester/year
 - Earning an A and 2 or less excused absences, OR earning a B and 1 or less excused absences, OR earning a C with 0 or less excused absences can help students become exempt from Semester Exams. NO students will be exempt from End Of Course testing in Semester 2
 - Students who score Advanced or Proficient on the EOC will be exempt from the semester exam in Semester 2.
- ALL Missing/Failing work* may be made up and/or remediated during Reaching Raiders.
 - **Students** should complete the Reaching Raiders Request form to schedule their attendance.
 - REMEDIATION work will be retaught/reviewed in REACHING RAIDERS only.
 - *Honors students should read district policy on LATE submissions and the resulting grades.
- **MISSING/LATE class & homework** not submitted by the end of the Quarter will result in receiving the corresponding grade from questions answered on the "Common Quiz" of the skills.
 - *excluding Honors Courses Missing class & homework will result in 0's per district policy
- **MISSING/LATE Quizzes** not submitted by the end of the Quarter will result in receiving the corresponding grade from the "Common Assessment" or "20 Day Test" of the unit.
 - *excluding Honors Courses Missing quizzes will result in 0's per district policy in Honors courses if incomplete by the end of the quarter.
- **EXTRA CREDIT** is ONLY earned by NOT using the 9 restroom passes allotted per quarter for a total of 9 bonus points and is added to Effective Effort Grades at the end of each quarter.
