**- Parents-please check Infinite Campus for student's meal account balance. Log on to [clarkschooldistrict.org](http://clarkschooldistrict.org), go to Parent Portal, and enter your same username and password that you use to check grades.**

**The low lunch balance letters will be getting sent out via email. The email will auto generate until your student's lunch balance is paid in full. You may pay at the Elementary office, High School office or online.**

**The Clark School District uses a, PRE-PAID food service program. All school breakfast and lunches MUST be paid in advance. Once a family/household lunch balance reaches a \$50.00 negative balance, children will not be allowed to purchase extra items or entrees. Please make sure your lunch accounts are kept paid up.**

For any family with low income needing assistance with school meals, please complete an application for free or reduced meals, these can be picked up at the office or found on our website. Please return the application to either school office as soon as possible so that your children may receive a nutritious meal each day. We highly encourage you to apply for this benefit as it helps our school district with funding.

**Important Reminder: After School Parents please remember to sign your child/children out with the after-school staff.**

#### **Reminders to Parents:**
