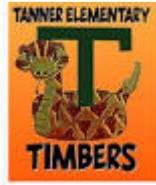


TANNER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PARENT AND FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PLAN OVERVIEW



What is Family Engagement?

Family Engagement means the participation of parents and family members in regular, two-way meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities ensuring:

- That parents and families play an integral role in assisting their child's learning.
- That parents and families are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education.
- That parents and families are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child.
- The carrying out of other activities, such as those described in Section 116 of ESSA.

How will Tanner Elementary School (TES) Implement an Effective Family Engagement Plan?

- TES will involve parents and stakeholders in the development of the Family Engagement Plan.
- TES will provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.
- TES will hold Parent-Teacher conferences, (at least annually), during which time this plan will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
- TES will provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress.
- TES will provide parents reasonable access to staff.
- TES will provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.
- TES will ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.
